

Auke Bay PTA Meeting  
November 4, 2010

Met in fishbowl (Library set up for book fair).

Meeting called to order at 6:07 PM

Minutes were approved with one spelling correction.

Site Council Report: Although the Site Council did not meet tonight, Tara printed off the first draft of the proposed 2011-2012 calendar and shared it with us.

Everyone is encouraged to send their comments in to Laury Scandling before the next calendar committee meeting at the end of November. We also talked about how early release is going, since one of the proposed changes is to have early release EVERY Monday.

We looked at the latest version of the Auke Bay School website. There is a link to updates about the Auke Bay renovation.

There will be an assembly performance of Git-Hoan Dancers on Friday (November 5th) morning.

Treasurer's Report – Current balance of \$33,868.01 (includes Innisbrook receipts of \$26,227 + \$25 donation, before we pay them off \$14,008.39. \$685.20 profit from the Internet orders. \$685.20 profit from the Internet orders – plus \$70 further donation). \$105 E-script intake for the month. 759.76 Internet total after everything ships. (\$26,285 catalog, plus \$1,872 Internet sales for a \$28,157 total, less shipping and handling).

There was unanimous consent to do Innisbrook next year. We will need to find a coordinator for that, since Ann won't have any children in our school then.

We are signed up to help fund Discover Southeast. There are a couple new PTA members that need processing (up to 53 members!).

\$89.86 requested to reimburse for nurse's snacks. We budgeted \$500 for the school year.

We have all our PTA required paperwork taken care of, except reviewing and amending our bylaws. Ann will send out a copy of our current bylaws and we can

start looking for things that need to be changed (like reflecting what we actually do). They will need to go out for 30 days review to the 53 members, so the whole process won't be finished before the end of the calendar year.

Silly Bands for boxtops – Denise has been doing this and this program and has raised \$268.60 so far this year! (at 10 cents per boxtop!). The money goes to the school, and in the past it has gone to technology for the school. [btfe.com](http://btfe.com) is a website where you can print coupons or your own collection sheets, as well as their marketplace that forwards you on to lots of online vendors like Target, Apple, etc. and some percentages is forwarded to the school. Ann passed along receipts for the school to reimburse Denise for the cost of the silly bands.

Halloween - \$834 was the gate receipt from the Halloween carnival. We still need to reimburse for the prizes, Waffle Shop gift cards for prizes. We budgeted \$1,200 but spent less than that. Andy got a lot of volunteers who built a lot of new games with their own resources. We also need to replenish AmyJo's prize box, since we were running a little short at the carnival. Everyone was very happy with the changes this year. Next year we should spend about \$600 for prizes, based on usage this year.

Yearbook – There was a question about what our school colors are. After some discussion, we concluded there are no official school colors. Jeanne Macaulay, Angie C., Ricky G., Kristina White, and Heather are the yearbook committee. Teachers need to have their class pages done by January. Will be doing a 40 page full-color \$8.74 per book is the cost. Will be asking for \$10.00 donation from each student/staff, probably starting in January or later. Angie had a great idea of printing up some cool envelopes to send home that students could put their donations in that would be less likely to get lost in the stuff that goes home with kids.

E-script (Safeway) – We HAD 150 members. We have only had 50 people renew, and only a dozen or so new members. If you don't know your number, you can call 1-800-SAFEWAY and they will give it to you. Ann would like to sign people up as they come in to pick up their Innisbrook or the book fair. Oh, and you can sign up extended family across the country who have a Safeway in their community they use.

Campbells & Boxtops – Ann is looking for someone to coordinate this. Involves counting them out in bundles of 50 or sheets of 10, printing out a label and shipping. Kris Pearson volunteered to do this.

Innisbrook pick-up is this Saturday. The book fair will be open then. The PTA has offered to give each teacher ten books of their choice from the bookfair. If they don't pick them out, they just don't get free books. We have Tara and Ann

alternating throughout the book fair. Preview starts tomorrow. The open times and ability to volunteer to work the fair are available on a bookfair website. Volunteers get \$5 discount cards.

Lori, Kim Holman, Ann, and maybe one more parent will help with the Innisbrook distribution.
